

## **Criteria for the:**

### **Vimy Ridge Scholarship:**

#### **Senior High Program**

**At this Division, there will be a scholarship competition for each grade level 10 through 12. Two successful candidates will be honoured with a financial award.**

**The successful applicant will demonstrate:**

- **Academic excellence – it will be expected that the successful applicant has received no failing grades (below 50%) in either core or complimentary subject areas at any reporting periods**
- **Community involvement-the successful candidate will be required to provide evidence of participation in the area of community or volunteer service**
- **A genuine interest in pursuing their education beyond high school through the completion of a career planning resume which is to be attached to the application**
- **Not less than two letters of reference in support of character, academic and the hockey component of The Hockey Program objectives will be required**
- **Role modeling traits as witnessed and documented by their instructors and teachers**

#### **Junior High Program**

**At this Division, there will be a scholarship competition for each grade level 7 through 9. Two successful candidates will be honoured with a financial award:**

**The successful applicant will demonstrate:**

- **Academic excellence, consisting of a combination of consistent effort and academic marks as evidenced in reporting periods throughout the year**
- **Community involvement – the student-athlete will be required to provide evidence of participation in the area of community or volunteer service(letter of reference will satisfy this need)**
- **Evidence of career planning as seen in responses on the application form**
- **Leadership qualities through on and off ice activities and as recognized by teachers and instructors**
- **A positive attitude toward all school initiatives as witnessed by instructors and teachers**
- **Letters of reference in support of character, academic and the hockey component of The Hockey Program objectives will be an asset**
